

RETAINED INTEREST: Wicks Cattle is retaining 1/3 interest share in every bull selling in this sale. Full possession and full salvage value sell with the bull.

Free delivery is provided by us or you are welcome to take your bulls home the day of the sale and bring them back for the semen test, May 1, 2012.
